- Unit 589 handed out Poppies at the Salinas Veterans Day Parade in November.
 They also set up a beautiful display at Salinas High School.
- Unit 694 mailed over 600 Poppies to Post 694 Legion Family members in May.
 The unit received \$2,317 in donations. This Unit always has Poppy displays and
 donation cans at the Post. Poppies are gifted to those attending Memorial Day
 and Veterans Day ceremonies.
