Madame District President, Chairmen, and Auxiliary members,

District 28 started the year by donating \$322.00 to the Department Nursing Scholarship fund. Then in our first district meeting we discussed and voted in our own district P.P.P Nursing Scholarship. With the 'Rally up' plus donations there is currently \$210.00 in that fund. Our current P.P.P Department fund stands at \$60.00.

One unit reported that they have a P.P.P. committee. No new committees in Units were started. 10 past and current President's attend the District 28 P.P.P. committee that meets in October and April. District and Unit leaders mentor members through instruction on programs, future events, seek out women Veterans, encourage members to attend workshops, discuss problems that Units are having and offer possible solutions.

Units reported that 8 members have completed A.L.A. Academic courses. 5 Units donated to the Department P.P.P totaling \$568.43.

Sadly, this year our District didn't have any applicants for the P.P.P nursing Scholarship. Scholarships were shared locally with Counselors at Community colleges that have a Bona fide nursing program. One Unit is currently working on a submission for Auxiliary Member of year which is due by June 1st.

3 Units sought out Women Veterans and recognized them by sending cards, and paying for occasional meals at feeds. 2 Units sponsored a total of 4 female Veteran members and paid for dues. Unfortunately, one unit that holds a annual luncheon to recognize female Veterans was unable to do so because of Covid.

Women Veterans that needed out patient services at Palo Alto Defenders lodge and patients at Spinal cord units were recipients of donations of toiletries, pantry foods, socks, care bears, and other items.

Although it was a difficult year, because of the Pandemic, 5 units accomplished significant goals. All the Units in our District did report in. Thank you all!
